Participants are required to book a minimum of 2 nights stay in the hotel starting from the accreditation day.



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Hotel Room Rates (Breakfast included, excluding city tax of €3.00 per person per night):

- Single Room: €110.00 per night

- Triple Room: €195.00 per night (only 14 available; includes fold-up bed, less comfortable than a standard bed)

- Exceptions: Italian players or those living/residing within a 50 km radius of the venue.

Registration Process

Step 1: Get your EPBF Player ID

Visit the **EPBF Player Registration** page.

Fill out your details and agree to terms and conditions.

Activate your account via the validation email.

Step 2: Register for the Event

Log in to the EPBF website: www.epbf.com

Navigate to **Tournaments** ? **Open for Registration** ? **Register Now** ?
Confirm Registration.

An invoice will be generated in your account, and you'll receive a confirmation email.

IMPORTANT CHANGE:

Players can register as usual but you will not appear on the participants list until you have paid. Paying with card via the stripe system is the quickest, bank transfers can take up to 24h. Once the field is full, the registration will close and entry fee payments over the allowed participant amount refunded. Registering does not automatically put you in the event,



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the first to pay will be accepted. (Time stamp on the payment will determine the order in the case of more payments received to the spots available)

Important: Cancellation of Announcements:

After registering and paying the entry fee, Athletes may cancel their participation without losing the entire entry fee if cancellation is made in writing at least two weeks before accreditation begins. All cancellations will incur a €50 administration fee. The entry fee will be returned minus the admin fee.

Entry Fee Invoices: If you wish that your club or sponsor pays your entry fee, please contact office@ibp.eu before paying. An invoice will be issued for your club or sponsor to pay. Invoices will not be changed after payment is made.

Participation Requirements

Players must be part of the WPA or EPBF member structure unless it's the first time of entry to the EuroTour events, see ET regulations for clarity.

Familiarize yourself with the tournament and EPBF sports regulations.

Familiarize yourself with the EuroTour regulations and by entering this event, duly accept them.

WPA Ranking points: All participants will receive WPA ranking points but the points will only be visible after you have received your WPA Athletes license.

The points are stored from each event and will be activated once the license is approved

Betting

Betting on matches during the event is strictly prohibited.



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Media Rights

IBPF reserves exclusive rights to use and distribute any form of media from the event.

Player Obligations

Comply with hospitality and promotional requests by IBPF.

Logos

Athlete Apparel and Sponsor Logo Regulations

Athletes may not wear shirts, apparel, or other clothing displaying the branding, logos, or names of any other tour, promoter, event, or competition.

The event organizer reserves the right to require the removal, covering, or replacement of any logo, branding, or apparel that does not comply with these regulations or has not been approved.

LOGOS & PATCHES



Shirts: Collared, long- or short-sleeved, all shirts are to be tucked inside the trousers.



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Athletes are permitted to wear up to six (6) sponsor logos on their outfits. Logos must not exceed 100mm x 50mm in size or 100mm in diameter for circular logos. Additionally, logos must not conflict with the tour sponsors.

At the request of the promoter, athletes may be required to wear the logo of the main sponsor during the Semifinals and Final.

- Up to 6 commercial sponsors spots
- Up to 3 apparel manufacturer logos
- If a manufacturer logo is bigger than the size permitted it will account for a commercial logo.
- These logos should be placed in positions 1-6 and/or 'C' on the diagram.
- Text on jerseys will be treated as a sponsor logo, unless it is the athlete's name, nickname, Club or country they represent. No Full back logos.

All sponsor logos must be approved by the event organizer and must not conflict with, compete with, or otherwise compromise the interests of the event's official sponsors.

Shoes: Dress shoes of any colour or all-black sports shoes.

Trousers: Dress pants and chino-style of any colour are allowed, no jeans, denim, or cargo pants.

Women's Division: Skirts and divided skirts are allowed, shirts can be worn outside the trousers/skirt.

Players Travel/health/accident Responsibility

Players are responsible for checking travel restrictions to/from events and are responsible for their own health and travel insurances and any other visas required. Personal injury claims are waived while participating in the event.
